Sampled **2** sites in the Chadakoin River for the presence of PFAS



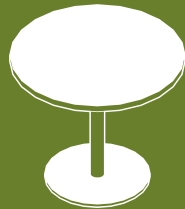
Co-sponsored **3** annual clean up events including Chautauqua Lake and the Conewango Creek
